

## Raytheon selects PRIMUS for programs

Williamsport, PA August 17, 2006 – Congressmen John Peterson Rep-House/ PA-5 and Don Sherwood Rep-House / PA-10 and PRIMUS Technologies today announced that Raytheon has selected PRIMUS as a subcontractor for seven defense programs worth \$15 million and carrying the potential of over \$20 million in additional awards over the next several years. The current contracts will sustain 58 jobs with the long term potential future awards creating 21 new positions.

PRIMUS Technologies has been a preferred supplier with Raytheon Missile Systems for 4 years. In the last 2 years, PRIMUS has been presented Performance Excellence awards by Raytheon Missile Systems (RMS) for outstanding customer service and program support. In April 2006, PRIMUS won the United States Small Business Administration's Region III Subcontractor of the Year Award resulting from an RMS nomination.

The referenced \$15 million in contracts are:

- New award in excess of \$8 million from Raytheon Missile Systems for electronic assemblies for the Maverick Missile Program. The contract will sustain 39 employees.
- New award of \$3 million from Raytheon Missile Systems for manufacture of electronic circuit card assemblies for the Joint Standoff Weapon (JSOW) program. This is an exercise of an option contract for JSOW under a long term agreement Raytheon and PRIMUS signed last year. This current contract will sustain 19 employees.
- New award of \$1 million from Raytheon Missile Systems for electronic circuit card assemblies for the Excalibur Precision Guided Extended Range Artillery Projectile.
- Additional new awards totaling over \$3 million from Raytheon Missile Systems in support of the Stinger, RAM, AMRAAM and Paveway<sup>TM</sup> precision guided bomb programs.

PRIMUS Technologies Corp is an electronic manufacturing service provider, producing circuit card assemblies, sub-systems and electro-mechanical assemblies for the military, medical, industrial controls, automotive and telecommunications industries. PRIMUS is locally owned by Jeremiah W. Sullivan, Robert P. Walker and Frank G. Pellegrino.
